## **Annual Members' Dinner - Thursday, January 12, 2012**

Please join us Thursday, January 12, for our annual members' dinner meeting. Our evening's speaker will be **Chief Inspector Andrew Brown of the Scottish Police College**, who will be discussing his experiences as a police officer and hostage negotiator in Scotland. He was the Area Commander (Chief Inspector) of Caithness, Sutherland & Easter Ross of Northern Constabulary and served in a variety of policing roles in urban and rural environments within Northern Constabulary. He also has significant experience negotiating in a policing environment, ranging from suicide intervention, siege incidents and hostage incidents throughout the Highlands and Islands. As the 2011 Scottish Fulbright Police Research Fellow, he is currently conducting doctoral research with the NYPD and FBI Hostage/Crisis Teams. He is also lecturing at the John Jay College of Criminal Justice, City University of New York on certain aspects of hostage/crisis negotiation.

We will meet at **The National Press Club, 529 14<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington, DC**. The National Press Club is located close to Metro Center. In addition to parking on the street, there is ample parking in nearby garages. The PMI garage is located on the north side of G St between 13th and 14th Streets. Carr Park is located at the corner of 15th and F Streets.

We will begin at 6:30 PM with cocktails followed by dinner at 7:15 p.m. Before we enjoy a fabulous three course dinner, new members will be piped in and inducted into our august body.
